






Make your eTwinning project come to life using VR & the Cardboard Camera app



The Steps

- We will use Google's Cardboard Camera app to create a simple virtual reality picture
- You will form into small groups of 4
- You will prepare a short script for your VR picture
- You will record your image, and narrate the script as you take the picture
- We will share our attempts with each other!

The Project Idea

Use VR to encourage your pupils to research local history, and create a virtual field trip for their partners.

- They will identify an interesting place
- They will research the history
- They will write a script for a virtual tour (I suggest 60 seconds maximum per VR image)
- They will visit the place and record their VR image
- They will share their images with partners


What to do

- Add the Cardboard Camera app to your phone
- Introduce yourself to your neighbours sitting beside, behind and in front
- Form into groups of 4
 - Take a moment to exchange contact requests on eTwinning (have you got the eTwinning app?!)

How does Cardboard Camera work?

It's simple!

- Open the app
- Take a 360-degree panoramic photo
- Simultaneously, the app is recording sound through your phone microphone to capture your voice
- The app converts this to a 3D virtual reality image.
- Generate a share link in the app, and email to your partner
- Your partner opens the link in their app.




Click here to take your VR picture



Spin on the spot slowly. The red bar will fill as you complete your full 360 turn

Press the centre button to start, and again to save your completed VR image

The sound bar will move to show it is recording

When the image appears Click **Save to App** in the bottom right corner




